Lights Out for Birds!

Spring Migration: February 15th-May 31st
Fall Migration: August 15th-November 30th

Over 200 species of birds migrate through the Bay Area each spring and fall. The bright nighttime lights of tall buildings can lure them off track and into deadly window collisions.

Save birds' lives, and save money and energy, too!

- Turn off workplace lights from dusk until dawn.
- If you need to work late, draw the blinds or use task lighting.
