Lights Out for Birds

Save birds' lives during spring migration by turning out office lights at night! Migrating birds are drawn by bright urban lights and often die in building collisions. What you can do: Turn off building lights at night. And when you need to work late, draw the blinds or use task lighting instead of overhead lighting. Spring migration season lasts from February 15 through May 31, but turning off lights at night can save energy and money year-round.
